Add a quirky touch to your ensemble with this jewellery set handmade using metal pins by China-born designer Josie Chen.



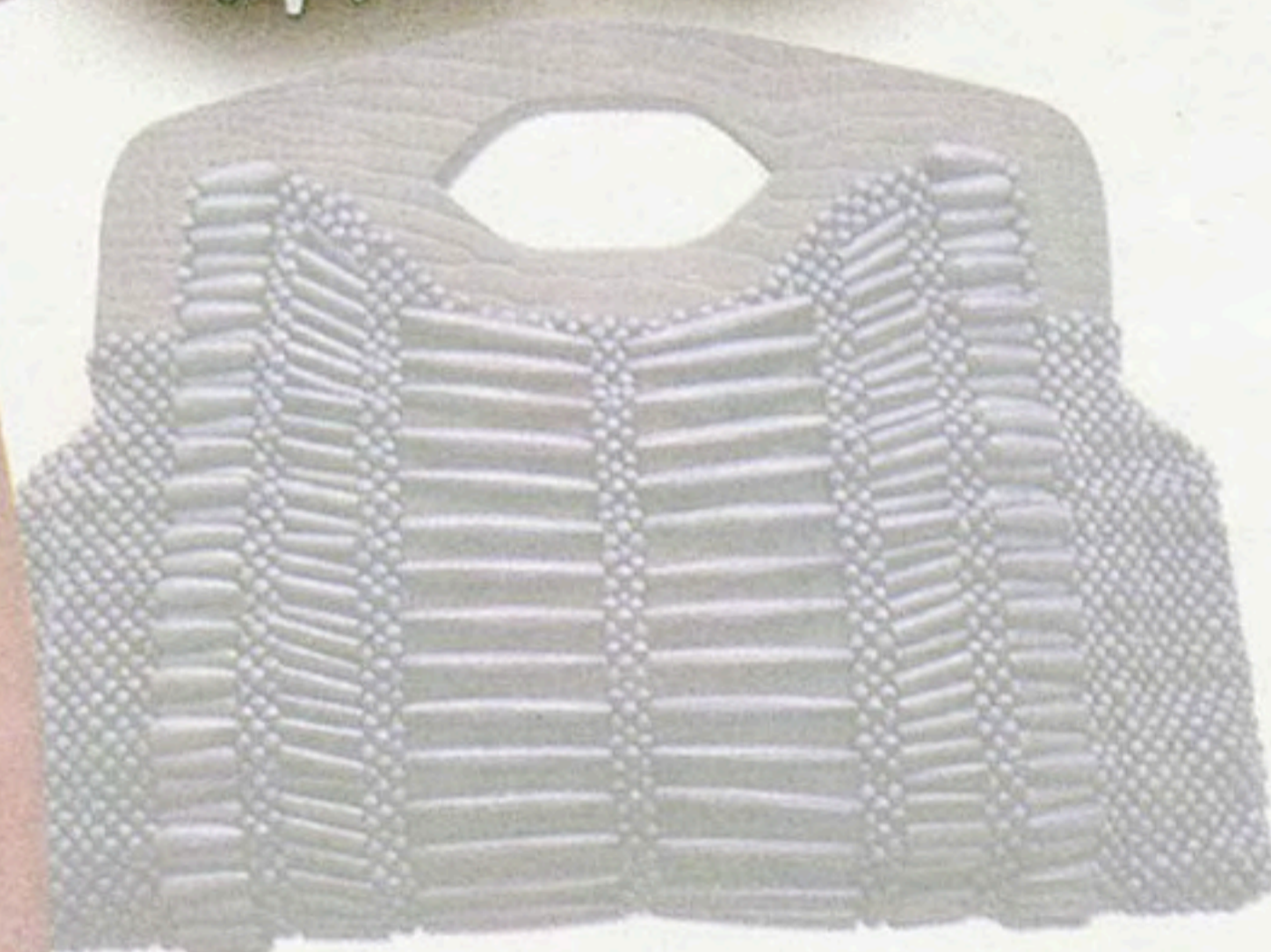
**TANK TOP, \$227, FROM ESTHER PERBANDT**
